Kort & bondig: De leerlingen maken na het ontdekken en inoefenen van nieuwe leerstof een snel te verbeteren oefening. De score die ze behalen bepaalt hun verdere oefentraject, zodat alle leerlingen op hun eigen niveau oefenen. Merk op dat bestaande oefeningen in leerboeken zich prima lenen tot het maken van een exit ticket. De leerkraacht hoeft dus niet steeds zelf opdrachten voor de exit tickets te verzinnen.

Stap 1: exit ticket

De eerste oefening van het onderdeel “Check 2 – Using personal pronouns” op p. 102 van *Track ‘n’ trace 3* (Van In, Wommelgem) doet dienst als exit ticket nadat de leerlingen geleerd hebben over personal pronouns. In deze oefening krijgen de leerlingen gatenzinnen aangeboden die ze moeten aanvullen met de correcte persoonlijke voornaamwoorden. Ze moeten daarbij zelf beslissen of ze gebruik moeten maken van de objectsvorm, het bezittelijk adjetief of het bezittelijk voornaamwoord.

Stap 2: oefenen op maat

- Leerlingen die een score behalen van minder dan 12/20 gaan verder met oefening 2, waarin een stapje terug wordt gezet. Immers, in deze oefening worden de oefenzinnen opnieuw opgesplitst per categorie: bezittelijk adjetief (deel a), objectsvorm (deel b) en bezittelijk voornaamwoord (deel c).
- Leerlingen die een score behalen tussen 12 en 15/20 gaan verder met oefening 4, waarin ze een gatentekst krijgen voorgeschoteld die ze moeten aanvullen met alle persoonlijke voornaamwoorden die ze al kennen (dus niet alleen de nieuwe vormen die ze net hebben geleerd). Bovendien is deze oefening iets uitdagender omdat het gaat om een doorlopende tekst, waarin de context soms iets minder duidelijk is dan in aparte zinnen. Immers, het antecedent van de voornaamwoorden is soms minder voor de hand liggend dan in de aparte zinnen.
- Leerlingen die een score behalen van meer dan 15/20 gaan verder met oefening 6, waarin ze de persoonlijke voornaamwoorden moeten aanvullen in een minder toegankelijke tekst, namelijk een songtekst (artistiek-literaire tekst) waarbij ze bovendien een aantal tekstbegrijpsvragen moeten beantwoorden.

Stap 3: nog verder oefenen op maat

Eigenlijk zijn alle oefeningen in het check-gedeelte van elk hoofdstuk exit tickets. De leerlingen maken oefening per oefening en hun traject wordt bepaald door de score die ze telkens behalen.


